



Read Me • Campus Ten/Twelve



Campus Ten & Twelve are outline versions of Apple's "Chicago" bitmap font.

But, in contrast to the TrueType version of Chicago that Apple includes with Macintosh System software, Campus Ten and Campus Twelve are true to the original spirit of the Chicago typeface.

Campus Ten and Campus Twelve preserve the "pixeled" square look of the original bitmap font, whereas the Apple TrueType version has "smooth" round outlines.

Campus Twelve produces, if set at 12 points, EXACTLY the bitmaps and spacing of the Chicago font.

However, the 12-point Chicago bitmap font really is comparable in size to a 15-point font. This is where Campus Ten comes in. If set at 15 points, this font produces exactly the bitmaps of 12 point Chicago. That is, Campus Ten is a bit smaller than Campus Twelve.

Character set: Extended Latin (Western and Eastern Europe), Cyrillic, Greek (uppercase).
